

General Rules for use of Camp Trinity RV/Tent Camping

- If you are staying at a campground, you must camp only in those places specifically provided or marked.
- All vehicles, RVs, and trailers must be parked on your campsite or driveway. Driving or parking off road is not permitted.
 - Quiet hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Please be considerate of others.

Sanitation

- Help prevent pollution by keeping garbage, litter, and foreign substances out of lakes, streams, and other waters.
- All garbage and litter must either be deposited in containers provided, or taken with you when you leave.

Campfires

- Obey any restrictions on fires. Fires may be limited or prohibited at certain times.
- Within campgrounds and other recreation areas, fires may only be built in fire rings, stoves, grills, or fireplaces provided for that purpose.
- Be sure your fire is completely extinguished before leaving. Do not leave your fire unattended. You are responsible for keeping fires under control.

Vehicle Operation

- Drivers must obey all traffic signs and operate their vehicles in accordance with posted regulations, and applicable Federal, State and local laws.
 - Vehicles must be parked in gravel areas only.
- Use of vehicles within campgrounds and other recreation areas is limited to entering or leaving those areas.

Fireworks

- Use of fireworks or other explosives within campgrounds and other recreation areas is prohibited.

Public Property

- Preserve and protect your campground. Leave natural areas the way you find them.
 - Do not carve, chop, cut and damage any live trees.

The Camp Trinity Campground has 3 full hookups (water, electric, & sewer). We also offer tent camping. Tent camping is on a first come first serve basis at all times. There is plenty of room available for tent camping.

We have showers & restrooms available at Shepherd's Shower House. We also have a dump station available.

The pool is available upon request when not being used by groups staying in the main cabins.

All fishing is catch and release only.

Canoes are available for use (life jackets must be worn). Canoes must be returned to canoe rack when not being used and life jackets and paddles returned to storage shed.

You can make reservations Monday - Friday by calling the Camp Office at 573-237-2072 between the hours of 8:00a.m. - 5:00 p.m. or via email. We will require a one-night deposit for each site within 10 days of making, the reservation or we will automatically take your name off the reservation list.

The rates for staying at the campgrounds are as follows:

- Full hookup (water, electric & sewer) (per night) \$30.00
- Water & electric hookup (per night) \$25.00
- Electric only (per night) \$20.00
- Tent camping (per tent) \$15.00
- Tent camping, groups of 25-50 (per tent) \$8.00
- Tent camping, groups of more than 50 (per tent) \$5.00
- Weekly fee for electric, water and sewer hookup \$175.00
- Monthly fee for electric, water and sewer hookup \$600.00
(Hookups for more than one month are not allowed)
