



Dear Fellow Servant in Christ:

We are truly looking forward to our servant event SERV’N IN THE HILLS scheduled for June May 31-June 5, 2026. We sincerely hope that you will be able to join us for this exciting event.

Servant Events are to “provide unique opportunities for spiritual, emotional, physical and intellectual growth in a work setting” and to “provide participants with different cultural experiences.” At our SERV’N IN THE HILLS, we hope to accomplish these objectives in a number of ways.

Worship, Bible Study, singing, work, reflection and community building will be important components of SERV’N IN THE HILLS. We will use these components to relate experiences of service to daily life and faith.

Participants will be working on several projects including new construction, reconstruction and landscaping. The youth will also work with the elderly in the local community for two afternoon work sessions.

We have enclosed an information sheet about SERV’N IN THE HILLS. A brochure of the camp has also been enclosed describing the facilities you would be using during the servant event.

We have provided you with one copy of our SERV’N IN THE HILLS Registration Form along with your Profile Questionnaire. Please fill out both forms. You may duplicate these forms for your own use. Each individual planning to attend our servant event must use these forms to register. We can only accept the first 80 participants so we encourage you to register early. A \$50 deposit is required for each person registering.

SERV’N IN THE HILLS Servant Event welcomes participants ages 13-18. Group sizes are normally 4-6 although larger are welcome. We need to have one adult leader for every 4-6 participants, representing males and females.

Adult leaders are an integral part of the servant event. They should be expected to use their leadership skills during this exciting week.

VI. *How to Register*

Please use the registration form provided. Only one registration per form. The registration form may be duplicated.

VII. *Registration Deadline*

Registrations are on a first-come first-serve basis. Deadline for the event is May 1, 2026.

VIII. *Registration Information*

Upon the receipt of the deposit and registration form, the registrant will receive a letter of confirmation, a listing of items to bring, emergency/medical information form, authorization to consent medical and dental care form and other information.

Registration is open to those who are 13-18 years old.

Youth groups must have a leader accompany them during the event. One leader for every 4-6 participants, representing males and females.

The maximum number of participants is 80. The minimum number of participants is 20.

IX. *Cancellation Policy*

If the program is cancelled due to lack of enrollment, a full deposit will be returned. The decision to cancel will be made at least one month before the event.

X. *Work to be Completed*

Participants will be doing various construction and landscaping projects on the camp property. Servants will also spend an afternoon in the community working with various elderly and needy citizens.

Insurance: The Board for Youth Services holds secondary travel and accident insurance coverage for Servant Event Participants, from the day before our event until the day after our event.

Timetable:

- Now: Distribute medical forms and Expectation Letter.
- By May 1: Mail medical forms, Profile Questionnaire and travel plans to Camp Trinity.
- After May 1: You will receive further information from us, including: a list of things to bring, a map, etc.
- May 31: Arrive at Camp Trinity after 6:00p.m. The fun begins!
